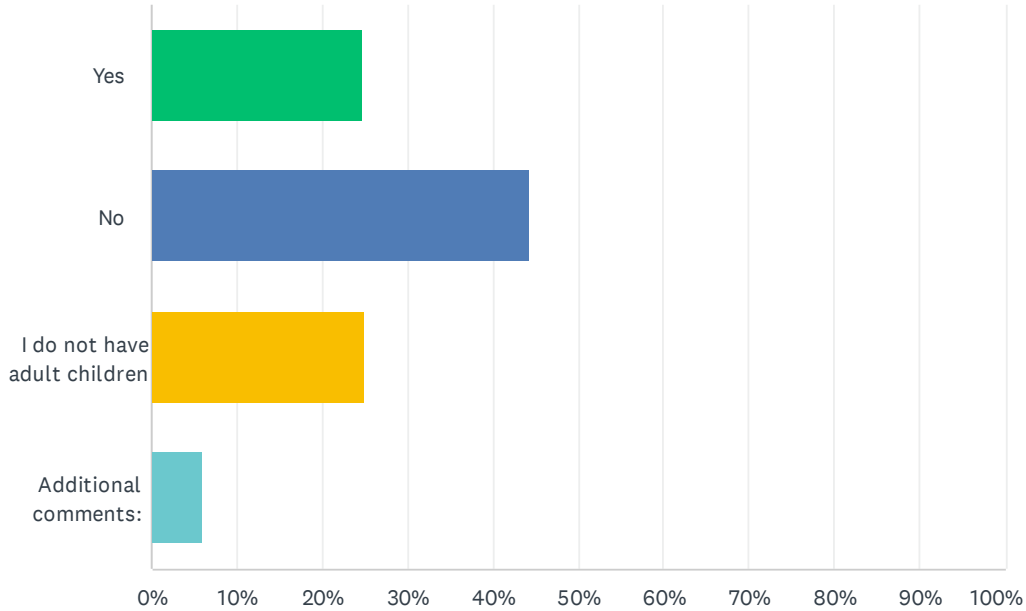


## Q20 If your adult children wish to reside in Seabrook, can they afford to do so?
