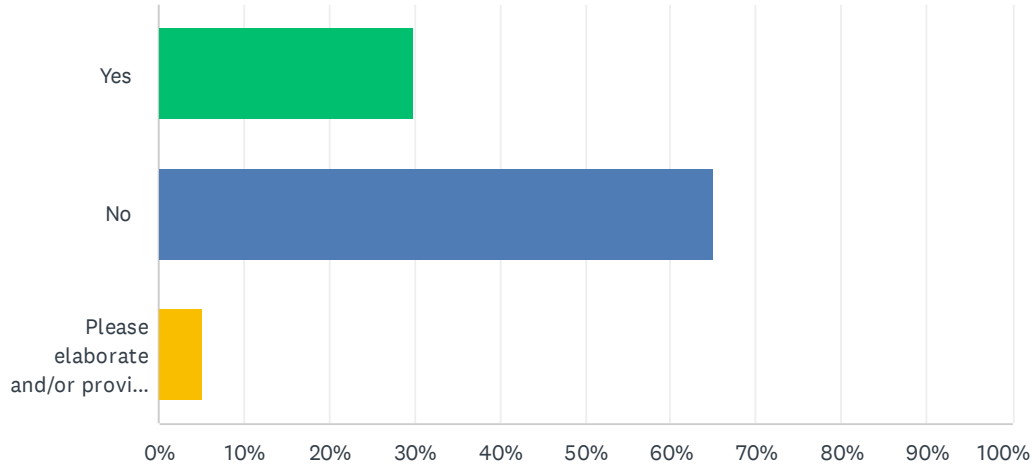


Q23 Have you, or anyone with whom you are acquainted, had a difficult time finding a smaller dwelling in Seabrook?
