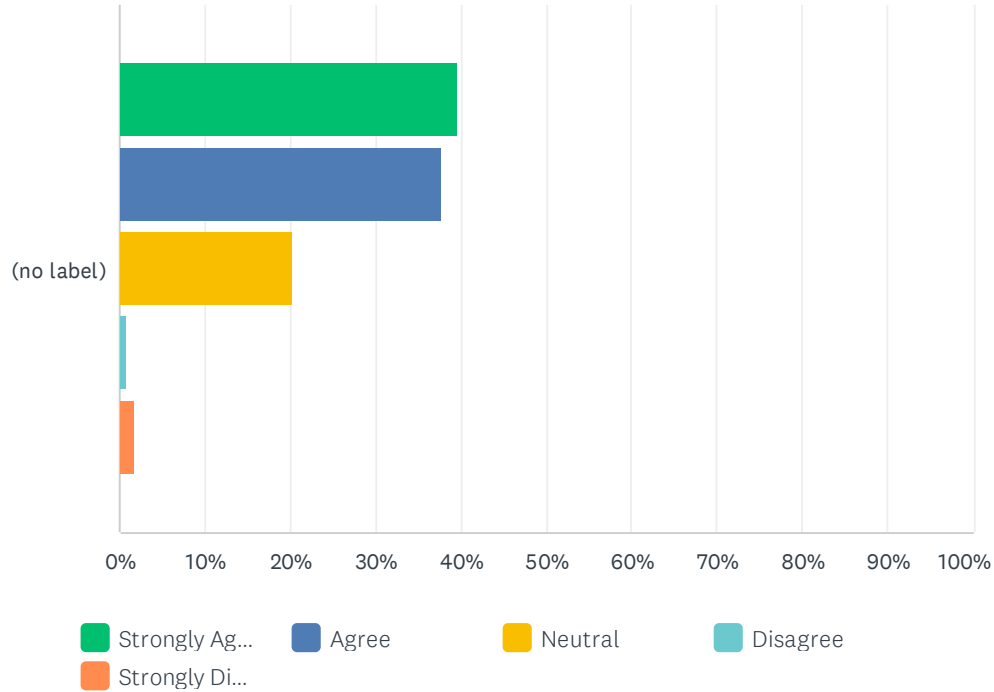


Q9 The Town should work with interested and willing property owners to conserve a greater percentage of land in town.
